Emergency Callout	£145 to £208	Weekdays - 6.00am to 8.00am / /6.00pm to 10.00pm - £145. Weekdays/Weekends - 10.00pm to 6.00am - £208. Weekends and Bank Holidays - 6.00am to 10.00pm - £185
Telephone Consultation	£37	towards a telephone conversation, where no follow-on treatment/appointment takes place.
Emergency Temporary Treatment - UK	£475 to £950	Individual treatment/benefit levels, subject to a maximum of £475 per incident and £950 in any 12 month period.
Emergency Temporary Treatment - Abroad	Up to £475	inclusive of emergency treatment and callout fees.
Hospitalisation as a result of dental trauma	£68	per overnight stay - maximum 365 days
Facial scarring benefit as a result of dental trauma	£50 to £500	Up to 5 cm - £50 Between 5cm and 7.5 cm - £100 Over 7.5 cm - £500
Redundancy Protection	£15 to £60	Plan Premiums paid for up to one year, maximum £15 per month for a single plan, or £60 per month for multiple plans on behalf of dependants with a waiting period of 30 days. Patients must have been employed for a minimum of six months. Does not apply to fixed-term contracts, self-employed patients, registration plans or company schemes.
